# From the airport to Saint-Etienne

#### Shuttle on Sunday

Some shuttles from the airport are under arrangement for Sunday afternoon - please send us your flight schedule as soon as possible.

#### Individual transfer

- At the airport, take the Tram to Lyon, <u>Part-Dieu</u> train station. The tram leaves every 20 minutes, from 4.30 - 23.40 hrs. Transfer time is approximately 35 minutes. Tickets can be bought train station. A one way ticket costs 13 euro. For more information: <u>http://www.lyonaeroports.com/Acces-et-parking/Venir-a-partir-de-l-aeroport/Par-Tram-express</u>
- From Lyon central Part-Dieu station, take the TER train to Saint-Etienne, <u>Châteaucreux</u> station: Departure on Mon-Sat every 30 minutes, at .19 and .49 hrs. On Sunday, every hour at .19 hrs. Transfer time is 50 minutes. Ticket: 9,60 euro.

For the return way the schedule is: Mon-Sat departure at .18 and .48 hrs, on Sunday departure at .48 hrs.

3. From the Saint-Etienne Châteaucreux station to the Hotel, take the tramway, direction Terrasse or Hop Nord. Stop : Hôtel de ville.

#### From Paris airport to Saint-Etienne:

- 1. Take the High speed train from the airport to Saint-Etienne. Must be booked in advance!
- 2. You arrive at Châteaucreux train station.
- 3. From the Saint-Etienne Châteaucreux station to the Hotel, take tram way direction Terrasse or Hop Nord. Stop : Hôtel de ville.

# From hotel to the course

Take tramway T1 from city center to terminus.

You arrive at the hospital. The Biology building is behind the hospital. Turn around on your right hand.

Biology building Grey/green cube. Enter, get upstairs 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.
