

ESCCABase is finally among us!

WHY ESCCA did it? Because ESCCA decided to invest time and money to provide you with a new revolutionary tool, able to let you compare your cytometric results with several fcs standard files, chosen for their typical behavior and their didactical meaningfulness.

WHAT is it? ESCCABase is a growing repository of fcs files you can consult on (but not download into) your computer. The files are distributed in different fields depending on the topic they refer to, and will be the basis of several future ESCCA activities like external quality assessment (EQA), distant learning courses, and so on.

HOW does that work? Enter in ESCCA site, choose ESCCA Platform, open Members section, enter Username and Password. When in ESCCABase page, download ESCCABase Viewer, which is the app you need to analyze the files, and then download ESCCABase General Directory PDF, which is a list describing the files available (their number will increase on time). Open ESCCABase viewer, choose your file, and begin analyzing it. If in trouble, browse the ESCCABase Viewer User Manual, available in the same page.
